

“For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “The just shall live by faith.”
The resurrection of Jesus from the dead justified you, and now made you the righteousness of God in Him.

Romans 4:25 KJV says;
“Who was betrayed and put to death because of our misdeeds and was raised to secure our justification (our acquittal), [making our account balance and absolving us from all guilt before God].”

Roman 5:8-10 NIV says more. It says;
“But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God’s wrath through him? For if, while we were God’s enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!”
To believe in His death grants you the opportunity to be saved.

JUSTIFICATION

Acts 13:39 KJV says;
“And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.”
Justification is not by the law of Moses but by the Grace of God, which is in the person of Jesus. Justification is to be declared free, not guilty, acquitted, and set free from sin and its consequences. Justification is by the working of Grace and not by the working of the Law.

Highlights;

1. Sin is not a concept about what we do wrong. It is a nature and person that enslaves men and causes them to live in opposition to God.
2. The grace of God destroys the power of sin, thus, setting you free.
Justification means you are no longer slaves but freed from sin and its consequences. This means you can now live the life God gave you. Glory be to God.

Romans 6:11-12 NIV says;
“In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Therefore, do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.”

HOW TO RECEIVE SALVATION?

Romans 10:9-10 KJV says;
“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart, man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth, confession is made unto salvation.”

Because you believe with your heart in the Lordship of Jesus and believe that God raised Him, all you need to do now is to boldly confess Him with your mouth to be saved.

Confession:

“OH LORD GOD, I COME TO YOU IN THE NAME OF JESUS. YOUR WORD SAYS, WHOSOEVER SHALL CALL UPON YOUR NAME SHALL BE SAVED. I BELIEVE WITH ALL MY HEART THAT JESUS CHRIST DIED FOR MY SIN, AND GOD RAISED HIM FROM THE DEAD FOR MY JUSTIFICATION. BY FAITH, I CONFESS WITH MY MOUTH JESUS CHRIST AS MY LORD AND SAVIOUR. I RECEIVE ETERNAL LIFE RIGHT NOW, AND I DECLARE THAT I AM SAVED, I AM BORN AGAIN, AND A PARTAKER OF GOD’S DIVINE NATURE. I RECEIVE HEALING IN EVERY PART OF MY BODY NOW, IN THE NAME OF JESUS. I WELCOME THE MINISTRY AND THE PERSON OF THE HOLY SPIRIT NOW, AND I DECLARE THAT I AM FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT AND ACTIVATED IN THE SUPERNATURAL NOW IN JESUS’ NAME, AMEN.

THE GOSPEL OF SALVATION

The gospel is the power of God unto salvation to anyone who believes (Romans 1:16 KJV). Humanity is in dire need of help for salvation. This salvation cannot be earned. No one can fix this problem for themselves. It's only by the grace of God. The grace of God is not a concept but a person. All are justified freely by the grace of God, in the person of Jesus through His cross, burial, and resurrection. That satisfies the legal conditions that made it possible for all who believed in Him (Jesus) to be JUSTIFIED, meaning; to be declared free, not guilty, acquitted, and set free from sin and its consequences. Hallelujah!

Acts 13:38-39 KJV says;

“Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: and by him, all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.”

It's very important to note that forgiveness of sin is not the same as Justification. Forgiveness of sin is a means to an end.

When Jesus went to the cross, we went there with Him with our sins. In other words, we were with Him on the cross as sinners, because the wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life (Romans 6:23 KJV).

Romans 6:3-6 KJV says;

“Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore, we are buried with him by baptism into death: like as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so, we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.”

Christianity is beyond the cross; the cross settles the penalty of sin concerning your sinful nature. Regardless, God has more for you, which is, the gift of eternal life. But before you can receive Eternal life, the issue of sin must be settled once and for all. That is only possible through the sacrifice of Jesus. Jesus volunteered to die for you with your sins, to offer Himself and His blood as the perfect sacrifice. With this, you ultimately obtained forgiveness for all your sins. Glory be to God.

Every record about you was erased and nailed to the cross. Every arrest warrant was removed from your file permanently, and you are forever declared free.

Colossians 2:11-15 TPT says;

“Through our union with him, we have experienced circumcision of heart. All of the guilt and power of sin has been cut away and is now extinct because of what Christ, the Anointed One,

has accomplished for us. For we've been buried with him into his death. Our “baptism into death” also means we were raised with him when we believed in God's resurrection power, the power that raised him from death's realm. This “realm of death” describes our former state, for we were held in sin's grasp. But now, we've been resurrected out of that “realm of death” never to return, for we are forever alive and forgiven of all our sins! He canceled out every legal violation we had on our record and the old arrest warrant that stood to indict us. He erased it all—our sins, our stained soul—he deleted it all and they cannot be retrieved! Everything we once were in Adam has been placed onto his cross and nailed permanently there as a public display of cancellation. Then Jesus made a public spectacle of all the powers and principalities of darkness, stripping away from them every weapon and all their spiritual authority and power to accuse us. And by the power of the cross, Jesus led them around as prisoners in a procession of triumph. He was not their prisoner; they were his!”

Romans 1:16 NKJV

“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.”

YOU ARE SAVED NOT BY YOUR WORKS BUT BY GRACE!

Ephesians 2:8-9 KJV says;

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast.”

Titus 2:11-12 TPT says;

“God's marvelous grace has manifested in person, bringing salvation for everyone. This same grace teaches us how to live each day as we turn our backs on ungodliness and indulgent lifestyles, and it equips us to live self-controlled, upright, godly lives in this present age.”
